

## LEAVE NO TRACE PRINCIPLES

- 1.- Plan ahead and prepare your trip.
- 2.- Travel and camp on durable surfaces.
- 3.- Dispose YOUR organic and inorganic waste properly.
- 4.- Respect wildlife.
- 5.- Do not start a fire (chilean law n° 20.653)
- 6.- Leave what you find
- 7.- Be considerate with others.

How to prepare a cathole to poop in the woods?



- 1.- Walk 70 steps away from any water source, camping and trail
- 2.- Choose a place without rocks and roots,.
- 3.- Use a small shover (ideally), stick or rock to dig hole (12 inches deep).
- 4.- After doing your business , spread the stool in the hole and cover it with the soil.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Search for information about the trails and schedules.

Keep in mind the duration of each trail, to return to Villa O'Higgins before the park's closing time.

Put special attention the changes of the weather and to the terrain conditions; walk carefully and be aware of the falling branches.

Use suitable clothes according to the weather and terrain, specially your shoes (avoid flat sole or sandals)

Use the public bathrooms located near the park's main entrance.

Take a bottle with water and some food with you.

If you want to climb, get information at the park's office first.

## NORMATIVE



Dispose your garbage on the thrash cans located at the park's main entrance.

You are allowed to camp **ONLY** in Puesto Rivera Refuge (Glaciar Mosco Norte walking trail).

Respect the flora, fauna and funga of the place, **DO NOT** feed or disturb any fauna (birds, insects, mammals, etc). **DO NOT** extract or cut flowers, fruits or fungus from the park.

**DO NOT** throw pollutant waste in the water.

In case you see a huemul, please notify to CONAF, SAG or to the park rangers.

Report any activity which affects the park's conservation.

Park's entrance is free during the whole year
